Developing and refining early writing skills
Kindergarten and First Grade

The **Writing For Fun** program is designed to build on a child's current writing abilities and then advance their skills with attention to correct letter formation and legibility. Based on the Handwriting Without Tears program, Writing For Fun uses activities that are engaging for both eager and reluctant writers. Writing games will be used to further enhance writing abilities.

Goals include:

1. Develop fine motor foundations including mature grip.
2. Improve visual motor control including coloring and drawing.
3. Develop correct letter formation.
4. Improve printing mechanics, with a focus on line placement, spacing, letter sizing, and organization of written work on paper.
5. Develop independence in writing sentences, if appropriate.
